I. REVOLUTIONARY PEOPLE'S PLENARY SESSION (SEPT. 5-7, 1970).

The purpose of the Revolutionary People's Plenary Session is to bring all progressive forces together for the Revolutionary People's Constitutional Convention, lay the bases and organize the structure for a Revolutionary People's Constitutional Convention, which will convene on November 4, 1970.

The Plenary Session will be the first step towards a constitution that will guarantee us the right to life, liberty, and the pursuit of happiness; a constitution that has the respect for the people, a constitution that serves the people instead of a constitution that serves the ruling class.

The Plenary Session will lay the groundwork for a true people's constitution. A constitution that takes into account the ethnic and pluralistic nature of this society, and that guarantees proportional representation to all of its people in a society free of the exploitation of man by man.

II. THE REVOLUTIONARY PEOPLE'S CONSTITUTIONAL CONVENTION (NOV. 4, 1970).

The location, agenda and particulars of the Revolutionary People's Constitutional Convention will be decided at the Plenary Session.

III. IMPLEMENTATION OF CONSTITUTIONAL CONVENTION INFORMATION CENTERS.

The primary task of the Constitutional Convention Information Center is to register people for the Plenary Session in Philadelphia. This will also include organizing and educating local communities around local and national issues; the distribution of information and the coordination of transportation of people to the Plenary Session and the convention.
