IN THE RUNOFF ELECTIONS

All three of us would like to thank everyone for the support that was given us in the election this past Wednesday. Your support has put us into the runoff election to be held this Wednesday, January 16. Now we are asking for your support again. Support from you that will enable us to make much needed changes within the union structure and much needed changes in relations between Metro management and unionized employees on the property.

We have put out our stand on issues confronting the union and our program for change. If you haven't yet had a chance to read it, we hope you will take the time to do so before voting. We have run throughout this election campaign as part of the Unity slate. In other divisions three Unity slate candidates have won the office of shop steward/executive board member and the new Second Vice-President was a candidate from the Unity slate. In addition Jack Thomas, Unity Slate candidate for Financial Secretary-Treasurer is in the runoff election. We hope that you will support Mayo-Waller-Simpson for Northern Division shop stewards and Jack Thomas for Financial Secretary-Treasurer so that we may join with other members of the Unity Slate to implement the Unity Slate platform.

At the Division level we have made a commitment to stand on the side of every union member in his dealings with management. The job of shop steward is often like that of a lawyer, the shop steward must defend a union member no matter what situation the member finds himself in. We will make that commitment to do so to the best of our ability.

The three of us have been pressing for changes all along. On the union floor we have fought for democratic by-law changes and against those that were to the detriment of the membership. We have fought for better safety on the buses winning a resolution on the union floor that a reward be offered by the union for information leading to the arrest and conviction of persons who assault Metro employees. In addition Phil Mayo and Craig Simpson served on the audit committee this past year that uncovered a number of glaring deficiencies and by-law violations in the union's financial practices. These are among the many changes we have pressed for. All of these changes will be greatly facilitated if we are elected to the position of Shop Steward/Executive Board member. We urge you to support us and vote in the runoff election Wednesday, January 16.
