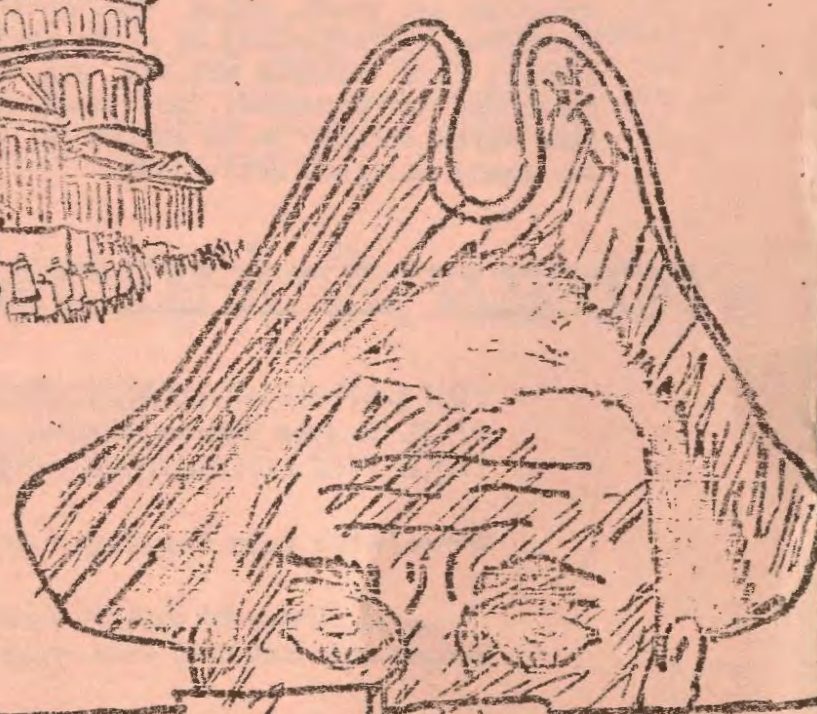
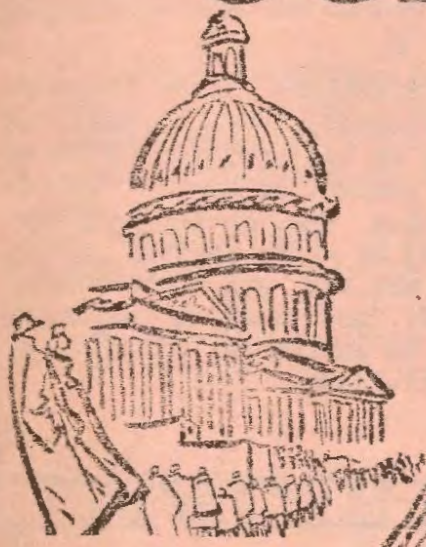
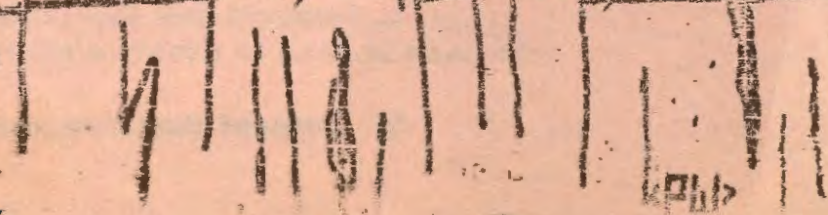

We have no voice in what happens to our city. The men who control our destiny are President Nixon (who appoints our mayor and city council for us) and his handful of puppet Congressmen who run D. C. from the House and Senate District Committees.

OUR SCHOOLS ARE CRUMBLING: Money for supplies, equipment, buildings, new programs, and teacher salaries must be appropriated by Congress. Ninety-three percent of D. C. school children are black, while the House District Committee is controlled by white racists. As a result: our schools are old and overcrowded; textbooks are outmoded; and teachers have not been voted a raise in 18 months as "punishment" for their militant activities.

TRANSPORTATION: Congress builds bridges and freeways for the commuting white suburbanites from across the Potomac, while we suffer with a decaying bus company that keeps raising fares.

HEALTH CARE: We have no control over appropriation of funds for medical care. Doctors at D. C. General Hospital have documented the charge that patients die daily because of lack of equipment and personnel.
