

DEMANDS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND SPRING ACTION COALITION

1. We demand that ROTC be terminated at the University of Maryland immediately (by Monday, May 10, 1971), and that all ROTC facilities be converted into a child care center. All Air Force personnel are to leave this campus immediately. All students in the ROTC program are to be given A's for ROTC courses this semester. Any ROTC student who is unable to continue his education without a government grant is to be given financial assistance from the university. ROTC students are to be relieved of their Air Force obligation.
2. We demand that the university implement the Peoples' Peace Treaty which was ratified by the Student Government Association and by the student body by ending all support for the military. We demand that the university make public a list of all research conducted at the university that is funded by any governmental agency, as the Department of Defense, CIA, HEW and any other branch. We demand that all military recruiting on campus cease, and that all university stock held in Honeywell Corporation, or any other war-profitting company, be terminated. In essence, all university connections with the military are to be severed immediately.
3. We want an end to the arrests, harassments, spying and other repressive actions taken against those who have protested the slaughter and genocide in Indochina. We want the administration to request the dropping of all state charges against persons involved in the protests, to end the suspension without due process of law and to refrain from further disciplinary action. We demand that the administration use its power and advise the state to cease legal proceedings against Larry Dean. We insist that the university allow any meeting of university persons and their non-~~union~~^{university} guests be allowed to take place without harassment.
