Dear Fellow Member:

The regular membership meeting will be held on Monday, November 22, 1971, at the Spingarn Senior High School, at 3:45 P.M. It is important that you attend this meeting so that you can participate in the policy formulation for the Union.

The following Constitutional Amendment will be submitted to the membership:

Article IX - Executive Committee

(New Section) 5. Paid Staff Positions

- a. All new paid staff positions shall be established by the Executive Committee subject to the approval of the membership.
- b. All changes in salary or other benefits for staff positions shall be established by the Executive Committee subject to the approval of the membership.
- c. Recommendations concerning the establishing of new staff positions and changes in salary and benefits for said staff positions shall be submitted to the membership in writing, and shall be voted upon by the membership at the first meeting following their submission to the membership.

Two vacancies exist on the Executive Committee - Vice-President, Librarians and Member-at-Large for the Elementary Schools. Petitions can be secured from the Union Office. Petitions should be returned by December 17, 1971.

A check for \$1028.76, the full amount of funds involved in the loss, has been received from the insurance company. A full audit report should be available in December.

Don't forget to vote on November 23rd and encourage all registered voters to do the same. It is important that the candidates supported by the Union, for the Board of Education, be elected. Organize your building to vote (car pools, phone network, etc.)
