


Fight the Cuts in the Unemployment Benefits !

EXTENDED BENEFITS to EXPIRE

The federal bill giving Emergency Unemployment Benefits runs out March 27, 1977. In Md. and D.C. these benefits were temporarily cut last year. With unemployment as high as ever, Md. and D.C. need these benefits restored. Instead the federal gov't. is cutting them nationally. This means we will be able to collect for 39 weeks only, instead of the 65 we got previously. As long as gov't. or industry won't hire us for decent paying jobs, we demand these benefits.

These cuts effect all of us, employed and unemployed. We will not be crushed. We are determined to fight them. Come to the public meetings and demonstrations.
