

THE FREE PRESS

The free press, according to the dictionary is a newspaper not controlled or censored by the government. We are a FREE PRESS. Not only by definition, but in ideology and price as well. We are a STUDENT paper; controlled, established, and serve the students. We are controlled by no one except the the students. Our is to voice the views and opinions of all the students and establish student unity and activism at the high school level.

ORIGIN OF A SPECIES

It all began last year at Deal when a few of us got together (After experiencing several futile and discouraging attempts at organizing several student movements and trying to create some sort of student activism at Deal), and decided to start a student newspaper. We felt (and still do) that Deal needed a newspaper through which the student body could express their opinions and whatever gripes they may have and make them known to those concerned. Many of the students felt they could not do so through the already established and recognized school paper the Deallite (or as we called it the "Deallight"). This was due to the fact that there was some controversy over censorship of the paper by the "faculty advisor".

Eventually two quote, "free presses" were published at Deal, THE CRUSAIDER and The Bandersnatch Chronicle. The success of these papers at Deal was limited however, for many reasons. One was both were late in getting started. (The Bandersnatch Chronicle came out in March 1970 and the CRUSAIDER came out one month later). The year ended before either paper really got off the ground. (Only two issues of each were ever published.) Also the fact that there was squabbling among the members of the two papers which led to petty rivalry and competition between the two which hurt the chances of either free press succeeding. The main reason for the free press at Deal not catching hold was apathy. Simply, too many students just didn't care enough.

Since then the two papers have merged to become "FLY BY NIGHT". We have learned from our past mistakes and with your help we hope to establish a high school free press at Wilson that will serve the students.

TO THE STUDENTS

As stated earlier we are a student newspaper. Fly By Night was established to give ALL the students at Wilson a chance to express themselves through the "free press". (This includes all Deal students

too) We will print anything you submit to us. (ie. Articles, Poetry, Announcements, Editorials, Ads, Etc.) All you have to do is write what you want to say and send it to us. We'll print it as you write it. There is no censorship and we'll print every article submitted. The only requirement is that you sign your material due to our editorial policy. We also offer free advertising to ALL students. If you have a gripe against the school or have been hassled by the school let us know. We'll publicize the incident and then act upon the situation. Also feel free to suggest ways to improve our (We, the students) paper. All suggestions are welcome. Don't be inhibited about submitting articles or poetry. We of FLY BY NIGHT believe; WHAT YOU HAVE TO SAY IS MORE IMPORTANT THAN HOW YOU SAY IT.

TO THE ADMINISTRATION

Though we are a "free press" we are not an antiadministration newspaper. This does not mean we won't make our presence known or felt when we feel you have acted unjustly or wrongly on a certain situation. It does mean that we won't come down on you just because you are the administration. In our quest to be as objective as possible, we would like and accept your opinion on any article or action we may print or take. Also feel free to submit articles on anything (pro or con) you wish. For we, contrary to popular belief, are interested in what you have to say (since most of the time it affects us, the students, directly) and hope the feeling is mutual.

TO EVERYONE

The following is a list of policies and procedures on which our paper is run.

EDITORIALS & ARTICLES

Since we are attempting to represent the whole student body, we will not have editorials as such, but instead we will have editorials by students who may take a position on a certain subject; BUT it will be their own personal opinion (or if it be the case, the group they represent) and not the paper's itself. (This is why we require that all material submitted to us be signed by their author unless they have a good reason for not complying to this rule.) All articles written by the editors or staff are their own personal beliefs and not the papers. (Unless otherwise stated and agreed upon by EVERYONE involved) In this way, we feel we can represent the whole student body not just a few and truly be a "free press."

Over Labor-Day weekend, a great American event took place. The people sat down in workshops and began to write a new constitution. All over the city of Philadelphia brothers and sisters began to formulate their ideas on the new society- what guiding principles the new society would be based on. Hundreds of pages were turned out. "THE MAD DOGS OF AMERICA MUST BE MUZZLED OR SHOT"

IF IT BE TRUE, as the bleeding hearts allege, that America is moving toward a "police state," the transition most assuredly is by invitation of those criminal anarchists who allow no other choice.

Consider the social disintegration reflected in the news accounts appearing in a single day's issue of a daily newspaper (using **THE STATE** of August 28 for convenience):


- In Portland, Oregon, civic authorities were preparing for violence from anti-war protesters seeking to disrupt a national convention of the **AMERICAN LEGION**.

- In Royal Oak, Michigan, white youngsters (mostly from well to-do homes) continued to clash violently with police who sought to suppress disorderly gatherings characterized by drug use.

In New Haven, Connecticut, black demonstrators continued to harass law officers during the course of a trial in which one Black Panther is charged with the murder of another.

- And so it goes around the nation, day after day, week after week. Anti-social individuals, whether motivated by personal depravity, criminal tendencies, or anarchist hatred of governmental establishments, take matters into their own hands—often in open defiance both of the law and of law enforcement agencies.

Bombings, assassinations, assaults, and indignities are heaped upon persons and places identified with the "Establishment". Policemen are killed with obvious pre-



meditated planning, innocent persons die simply because happen to be at the wrong spot at the right time, and the orderly course of domestic life is disrupted.

In short there are mad dogs loose all over America—made all the more dangerous because of the fawning approval given them by professional do-gooders, effete interlecturals (to borrow from Vice President Agnew), and apologists for the imperfections of modern society.

Unhappily, the situation seems to be worsening despite all the billions of dollars and bushels of advice being dispensed in the guise of public welfare and participatory democracy.

The self-discipline which channeled the energies and promoted the accomplishments of America's founding fathers seems to have been replaced by a permissive indulgence or an apathetic indifference to consequence.

But if Americans are to preserve their government, their domestic tranquility, and indeed themselves, strong measures must be taken—and soon. If internal discipline cannot be engendered, external discipline must be applied.

At long last, the legal profession (which is more responsible than any other single category of the citizenry for the administration of justice and the preservation of law and order) seems to be facing up to the situations it has let get out of hand.

But it remains for the average law-abiding God-fearing, decent American to insist that peace, and

When Mike Nichols and Buck Henry set out to make the film **CATCH-22** they were faced with a problem bigger than making **MYRA BREKINRIDGE** was for Michael Sarne. The thing was, **CATCH-22** is a great film, but **MYRA?** well that's a different matter. **CATCH-22** was once a national best seller written by Joseph Heller, and everyone knew it was only a matter of time before it became a film. The man who finally took on the directing chores was vet Mike Nichols, whose past credits include "**WHO'S AFRAID OF VIRGINIA WOOLF?**" and "**THE GRADUATE**" both very successful films. Buck Henry, creator of Maxwell Smart ("**GET SMART**") and other things did the almost impossible task of writing the screenplay as well as playing Colonel Korn in the film. **CATCH-22** has a whole herd of stars, including Alan Arkin, Richard Benjamin, Arthur Garfunkel, Jack Gilford, Buck Henry, Paula Prentiss, Anthony Perkins, Bob Newhart, Martin Sheen, Jon Voight, Martin Balsam and Orson Welles.

The best all around acting comes from Richard Benjamin as Major Danby, and Orson Welles as General Dredle (But what else is Welles famous for?).

In case you never read the book or any articles about it **CATCH-22** concerns B-52 bombers and the pilots who fly them and the nasty colonels who raise the number of missions required, and about a fighter pilot named Yossarian and about a catch in Army-Air Force rules that states that if you want to get out of flying missions you can't be crazy so you can't get out of it on the grounds that you're crazy, but if you want to fly missions you're crazy

and could get out of it if you wanted to, but no one who wants to fly missions wants to.

CATCH-22 is another film in the series of anti-something or other films and joins the ranks of **M*A*S*H**, **The Strawberry Statement**, **Getting Straight** and a few others.

"**22**" is one of the better films of the year, and certainly ranks with **D.R. STRANGELOVE** as one of the best anti-war films ever made.





COMPARED

SOME OF THE PRESENT USES OF THE AMERICAN MILITARY MACHINE IN VIETNAM

Prior to the outbreak of World War II there occurred a leftist movement in Spain in the form of a civil war against the government then in power. Only with the use of a certain Commander Franco's forces in North Africa could these forces be smashed. But the leftists controlled the Navy and there was no way Franco's men could be brought into the country.

It was then that a request for military aid was sent to the German army. The Germans agreed to send this aid. In fact it ended up that Spain owed Germany over 150 million Reichmarks before it was all over.

Germany supplied the support for these reasons:

1. To avert the spread of communism (Which the Germans believed the Leftists represented).
2. To gain access to Spain's ore supplies.
3. To test their newly formed Air Force (Luftwaffe) and their Panzer tank divisions.

During the Nuremberg trials of 1946 it was stated by Goering that "When civil war broke out in Spain, France sent a call for help to Germany and asked for support, particularly in the air... The Fuemher thought it over. I urged him to give support under all circumstances: firstly to prevent the spread of communism; secondly to test my young Luftwaffe in this or that technical respect." And indeed the Luftwaffe was tested for it proceeded to transport tens of thousands of Franco's troops across the Mediteranean and into Spain. It also utilized the divebombers by using them to support the Panzer divisions forming what known as The Lightning War (Blitzkrieg). The Germans were also testing and training thousands of young men for war under the best conditions -real war!

It would be hard to name all the weapons that the U.S. has introduced in the war in Vietnam. To name just a few: defoliants, smelling machines, napalm bombs, massive helicopter assistance, and refined bombing techniques. All this equipment takes a highly trained group of American servicemen to operate. And while they are operating it they are training under the best conditions-real war!

Has it also ever occurred to you that a certain faction in America which has one of the largest armies in the world if not the strongest might feel a need or even the right to use her army in another peoples country in order to protest herself and use it as a laboratory?

Germany, then, having one of the largest armies in the world had nothing to lose by siding with Franco, but had a world to gain.

I didn't hear much about withdrawing American troops from Vietnam like President Nixon said we would until people spoke out.

A nice slow and safe pullout. Slow but safe. Ten years before we can clear the North Vietnamese out of South Vietnamese villages. Ten years is a long time for many deaths and much sorrow. Ten years of using another country as a death laboratory.

Let's keep the call of peace heard and bring our brothers home. NOW!

American Film Institute Theatre



The overwhelming public response to the AFI Theatre's first six-month season has allowed us to go full-time in a big new theatre. With your support and the generous co-operation of the film industry, we have the opportunity to create a unique institution in the Nation's capital.

We plan to explore every aspect of world cinema, 364 days a year, a different program every night. We shall endeavor to show every kind of film that has merit, excluding only those that are readily accessible in commercial cinemas.

Our brief will include, not only feature films, but documentaries, shorts, experimental and student work, films made for television, programs of special interest to the black community, schools and colleges, lectures on film art and technique, and discussions with filmmakers. Quality films appealing to parents and their children will be shown on Saturday and Sunday afternoon. Themes of topical concern will be examined in order to demonstrate the interreaction of film with everyday life. Even Hollywood, the dream factory examined contemporary manners with uncanny insight. Now that cameras are increasingly taking to the streets, the social relevance of cinema is as important as its artistry.

This opening program comprises a selection of outstanding new productions from unknown and established directors, the largest John Ford retrospective ever mounted, and a tribute to the work of Emile de Antonio. Some of the films need little recommendation; we hope you will take a chance on the less familiar titles, for everything in this program has the potential to entertain or provoke, and many of the early Fords, for example, will come as a revelation to those who haven't seen them.

The program ranges widely both in technique and content, and a few films strike extreme postures of libertarianism or reaction. We don't see it as our job to take sides politically or to act as censors. If a film has merit then it deserves to be shown, all the more so if it contributes to some current controversy. A couple of examples. Many of Ford's films are uninhibited paens to military prowess and patriotic pride; his treatment of the Negro and Indian is often illiberal. Such prejudices were common currency when the films were made. Yet Ford is in many ways the most timeless and humane of directors, whose attitude toward authority is anything but servile. On the other hand, *Right On!* and the political documentaries of Emile de Antonio should be seen, even by those who will find their militancy offensive. Unlike so many gestures of protest against the established order, they are thoughtful, deeply serious achievements. As Jefferson remarked: "Error of opinion may be tolerated when reason is left free to combat it."

The American Film Institute is a very good way to see quality films that are hard to get to see anyway, for a cheap price. They will show films 364 days a year at their new theater at L'Enfant Plaza for a \$1.25 (\$1.50 for each guest) for each performance. A membership will only set you back \$10 (\$5 for students). For anyone interested in films, or just someone who likes to see good flicks, this is the best thing D.C. has to offer. However all the blame can not be placed on "Red Tape", a large part of the problem is with the students themselves. To an extent, the students can make or break a school, and in the case of Deal the students have chosen to slit their own throats. Only a small part of the school (about 15% at its peak) has ever gotten together for any kind of movement.

The whole movement thing at Deal began for me in eighth grade with the "Peace And Freedom party" a political party started by some liberal students who were attracted by the name mostly. In this organization I went from a member to the president and over these months all that was accomplished was a bunch of pamphlets on Black history given to the school by party.

The pamphlets were virtually ignored.

The party failed because the members would rather go buy a coke at Drug Fair than do anything that would accomplish anything.


Many months later, when I was in the ninth grade, a small group apposed to the Vietnam War arose and picked up speed as November and the moratorium approached. It had meetings, got larger, a leadership group was chosen and then the group became an official Mobe faction. And then it fell apart.

The dispute that killed the movement was over a triviality about if the group would attend as a group or as an individuals. Some people couldn't come because

cause of their parents. The movement at Deal was dead.

In the months that followed a small group of people continued the movement with various hit and run actions such as raising peace and other banners, passing out pamphlets and posting bills. Then the school year ended and most of the students who had previously engaged in the movement, left. So, with all the problems facing the world, nothing ever got off the ground.

One thing is for sure, when the revolution comes, it sure as hell isn't going to start at Alice Deal. And so you students of Deal who must brave 1, 2, even 3 years more of school there are pledged the assistance of this paper in organization of a new movement. We will make printing arrangements for any right-on pamphlets you have and want to spread around. You are left to fight the oncoming charge of administration harrassment and red tape as well as the apathy that thrives in your midst as it did in ours. Maybe you will have better luck with your new principal than we did with ours, but don't make him your enemy unless you have to. This is the end of our plea to you, for the fight is no longer ours. But we beg of you to carry on the struggle for a decent school as well as for an end to U.S. Military involvement in S.E. asia, the war machine, and the goals of the new left.

BLUES NEWS

For all you blues freaks in Washington we have a surprise for you. With the rising popularity of both rural and urban blues in this country many cities are having their own blues festival and now Washington is. It will be at Howard University on November 6 and 7 and although we're not sure of the lineup, it includes Junior Wells and Buddy Guy who are worth the money alone.

If you are having trouble finding blues records besides the white performers like Winter and Mayall here are some tips. What you have to do is know the labels which have the blues records. A few of them are, bluesway (B.B. King), Chess and Checker (the best of Chicago blues), Delmark (also very good Chicago including some of the lesser known west side singers), Vanguard, and Everest (for good re-recordings of old 78 r.p.m. records collected together into L.P.s, some very good folk-blues). Then go down to a good record store (for blues I recommend Discount Records on Conn. Ave.) and look underneath the records grouped in different categories and find where they group records by the label and find the ones mentioned above. This way you'll find the best blues by the people who have paid their dues and also need the money.

I've had my best luck with Delmark but you may be different, but in any case good luck and good blues listening.

(Sorry about that) SO WE ARE NOW PUBLISHING THAT ARTICLE IN THE FIRST ISSUE OF FLY BY NIGHT AND HOPE YOU WILL ACCEPT OUR APOLOGY FOR THE DELAY.

This is written from the desert isle of Montgomery County by a transplant into its midst and the number one hater of suburbia.

Suburbia is merely a plastic-people jungle. They talk about their integrated suburbs, ("Why there must be about ten Negro children in my child's school!") and regard cities as a place where there is only crime and riots which occur every other day. DOPE + CAPITALISM = GENOCIDE

Brothers and sisters of D.C., dig! There is a tremendously vicious problem in habiting D.C. dope! Yes, dope! Do you realize that your brothers and sisters are being murdered on a daily basis? In Turkey there are poppy crops grown specifically for Amerikkka, and the French have machines made to refine this plant into poison for Amerikkka. Starting last summer, (summer is the time of year when the heat, rats, idleness, and all of the existing conditions to make people suffer, tempt a brother to get hooked) heroin caps contained 50% more heroin, than a month before summer started. I am totally convinced that if the pig government wanted to stop the flow of poison, then they would get off their squiggly little tails and really help the people! Instead they have (as always) found a way to capitalize off of the lives of our Black people, and let them remain in the deplorable conditions; and laugh as our people slowly die. It is to me crystal-clear, as a "Black Man" that the greedy-pig government is playing right along with Heroin addiction. They make money and kill Black people at the same time.

They let the poison come in from Europe through New York, Canada, Mexico (any of the big, populated areas), then a big policeman sees a brother "strung-out," and mercilessly throws him in prison (but not before the brother whores his wife, or robs and kills another brother) where he suffers miserably, and eventually dies. If he's lucky, he will get out of jail before he dies, and get back in the streets where he slowly commits suicide and fratricide, while the pigs are some where waddling in the mud!

My rap to you, brothers and sisters, is to get together with your community and keep all pigs out! (Pigs come in all shades, shapes & sizes).

One of the best community houses in D.C. is the "Blackmans Development Center" (Black Liberation Army). There have been more than 14,000 registered addicts there since they started in May, 1969. This great number can be partially explained by the fact that the center genuinely wants to stop dope, and don't hamper a brother about how many crimes he committed on dope etc. These centers are actually an "army" extended from the United Moorish Republic, a Pan-African movement dedicated to breaking the chains of any type of slavery against Black people by any means necessary.

The most successful and acknowledged program has been with drugs. The first time I checked out the center, it amazed me at the readily available facilities; dormitories for ex-addicts and their families (clothes, food, etc.), doctors offices, medical rooms, conference rooms, kitchens, printing rooms, class rooms, and countless other facilities designed to help the Black community.

The part of the center which really "blew my mind" was the brothers being taken from court on the "third party system," which means that if a brother is being detained for dope, the center's lawyers take custody of the prisoner, and provide clothes, treatment, education, and shelter.

Please! Don't take my word for this beautiful community "oasis", come in and check it out for yourself. Anybody can come in and dig it. Projects like this cannot function independently (the capitalist government only granted \$10,000, which was devoured in five days). It needs volunteers, and anything you've got to offer. The centers are in D.C.: 6406 Georgia Ave. N.W., 1642 Newton St. N.W., 1407 "H" St. N.E., and 1333 "T" St. N.W. Open 24 hours a day.


Panthers vs Police article by KENNY DYE

In recalling several police raids on Black Panther Party headquarters recently it becomes increasingly evident that these raids are a reflection and a manifestation of the problem of police oppression in black ghettos. The harassing nature of them relate to it directly. The average ghetto dweller is somewhat apprehensive & scared of the thought of being questioned and/or arrested by the police. Pigs patrolling black communities (and other communities) are so unpredictable that being caught loitering could result in a friendly hello to a 5 year jail sentence (depending completely on the pig, not the law). Another example of police oppression of ghetto brothers, sisters, and Panthers is the needless harassing searches of both houses and of people on the streets in the community.

Because the Panthers are men willing to stand up, fight, and die for the rights of the oppressed Americans, J. Edgar Hoover has called them the most dangerous threat to our society today, therefore they must be systematically disbanded, demolished and exterminated. Pigs everywhere have reacted to the statement by raiding Panther offices everywhere. Usually these swine stalk their game in the early morning before dawn when most people sleep (partially to catch them off guard and partially to retard the number of possible eyewitnesses). This was the plan used by head hog Frank L. Rizzo of Philadelphia police department.

On this raid, early one Monday morning several weeks ago, Rizzo's raiders surrounded a B.P.P. headquarters and attempted to chop down the door. As this effort proved useless they were greeted with gunfire. The pigs returned the favor and ultimately the shootout ended with the Panthers surrendering to the police. Occupants of the house were lined up against a wall, whereupon all the males were stripped naked in a gun search. The gun search was a classic example of pig harassment stemming from racist and fascist attitudes. After all, how many guns can you hide in your underwear? These pigs are such idiots that they can't even correspond their lies. (The raiders said that they tossed a few canisters and then were fired upon, whereas Rizzo contends that his men knocked on the door and then were fired upon). Furthermore, Rizzo wasn't ever fit for the position of Head Man in Philadelphia! His statement, "If they had any guts they would call me and set up a show-down if that's what they want. We'll even give them the odds.... We'll send out fewer people with fewer weapons" proves that he isn't. This may not sound too strange to some of us coming from a pig; but coming from the man who is in control of the protection of hundreds of thousands of lives and countless dollars worth of property this statement sounds very frightening, and to say the least, unforgivable.

The time has come for the end of these gestapo-type tactics. If they persist there will be much more guerilla retaliation (such as in Chicago recently) against these low-life swine. Because of the unlawful nature of the raids on B.P.P. headquarters and everyday harassment of black people, and being a young black man myself, I find it hard to condemn the shooting of police. While the killing of a human is basically wrong, the destruction of a dangerous beast is necessary for survival.

JONATHAN

JACKSON

As some of you have probably noticed, some spray paint revolutionary has gone wild on the steps of Wilson. One of his works of art says, "Live like Jonathan Jackson." "Who the fuck is Jonathan Jackson?" and "Why the hell should I live like him?" are some questions that this pearl of wisdom generates in my brain.

On August 7, 1970, in the Marin County courthouse in San Rafael, California, seventeen year-old Jonathan Jackson walked in carrying a satchel with him. This was during the trial of James David McClain, age 37, who allegedly stabbed a guard at San Quentin where he was serving time for wounding an Oakland pig. A guard accosted young Jackson, whereupon he pulled out a gun and gave other guns from the satchel to McClain, William Christmas (age 27), and Ruchell Magee (age 31), who were also charged with allegedly stabbing the guard at San Quentin. The four men then walked out of the courtroom, taking the judge, prosecutor, and three women jurors with them as hostages, so as to ensure their safe escape. They entered a van parked in the parking lot outside the courthouse, still holding the hostages, and attempted to drive away, but a pig blocked their exit and shot at the van, thus starting a gun battle which lasted for several minutes. The pigs did not even consider the safety of the hostages when they started shooting, which clearly shows how enraged they were at the fact that four black men had stood up to the racist court system and had taken five white people with them, including three white women. At the end of the gun battle, Jonathan Jackson, James D. McClain, William Christmas, and the judge were dead. Ruchell Magee, the prosecutor, and one of the women were wounded.

The pig news media tried to write this incident off as being a criminal act, and even lied about who shot first. They claimed that Jackson had shot first, and it is now known that a policeman shot first. But, it was not a criminal act, rather it was a revolutionary act, one of four men choosing death instead of being railroaded into jail by the Amerikan judicial system.

Brothers McClain, Christmas, and Magee had all been imprisoned in jails for a good part of their lives, (Christmas for eight years and Magee for five), and had seen the oppressive conditions in Amerikan prisons. They had seen their brothers killed and beaten by sadistic prison guards. They had seen brothers thrown in-

to the inhuman circumstances of solitary confinement for months at a time. They had also seen the harsh repression of political activists in the prisons. These four men would have rather died than be returned to the gross realities of them. These men's actions shows that black people in this country will no longer accept the two-faced nature of Amerikan justice, which will allow the rich to go free, and clamp the steel shackles of fascism on poor white and black people. Black people will no longer accept white man's justice, with the juries consisting of mostly white people, whose average conception of justice is totally different from the average white person's, because of their different experiences and environment; and the public "public defender" in which the poor man gets the young, inexperienced lawyer, or the old, incompetent and not receptive to a black man's needs one, while the rich can afford a good, private lawyer. In other words, black people are standing up to the white power structure and demanding that they be spoken to, as men.

Jonathan Jackson, William Christmas, James D. McClain and Ruchell Magee, have brought the struggle of black people in this country to a higher level, for they have come right out and said, in essence, "Freedom or death!" to the reactionary pigs.

Revolutionary funeral services were held on August 15, 1970 at St. Augustine Church in Oakland, Calif. for Jackson and Christmas. Three thousand people came.

Jonathan Jackson was seventeen years old, as young as most of the seniors in Wilson. This brother gave up his life to free three political prisoners of war, thereby setting the example for others to follow. Live like Jonathan Jackson!
