## "THROW THE BUM OUT!"

### A Gay Umpire's Life in the Big Leagues

**The explosive story of a famous  
umpire's double life in the macho  
world of major-league baseball**

**WASHINGTON, DC** — Former National League umpire Dave Pallone, author of *Behind the Mask: My Double Life in Baseball*, will make a guest appearance at Lambda Rising's Washington, DC, store on Wednesday, June 27th from 7:30 to 9:30 PM. The public is invited to meet this controversial sports figure.

Dave Pallone first attracted public attention when Pete Rose shoved him in a 1988 Reds-Mets game, igniting one of the most controversial incidents in baseball history. Rose was suspended for 30 days and fined \$10,000, and the incident cost Pallone a World Series assignment. At the

end of 1988, Pallone was released from baseball. The National League claimed he was guilty of "unprofessional conduct." Pallone insists he was found guilty only of being gay.


Published by Penguin USA, Pallone's new book, *Behind the Mask*, (hardcover, \$18.95) is a revealing look at baseball through the eyes of an umpire with two unique perspectives on the game: one, the man in blue, cursed by fans and players alike; and two, the stranger in a strange land — the gay sensibility in a macho sport. Pallone traces his life from the rigors of umpire school to the small-time charm of the minor leagues, to his first job in the majors, when he crossed the umpires' picket line in the controversial strike of 1979. It is the story of the ultimate baseball outcast: a gay "scab" ump.

"Leading a double life for a decade was not easy," Pallone said. "Obviously, I could never be myself...I think I must have developed a crick in my neck from constantly looking over my shoulder. I'd be introduced in a gay bar, for instance, and the inevitable question was: 'What do you do for a living?' For years I would lie." Only three non-gays in baseball knew about Pallone's gayness — two umpires and Bart Giamatti (then National League president, now Commissioner of Baseball).

Deadline for submission of your novel is January 31, 1991. Members of Lambda Rising's staff will select five finalists from the entries and the winner will be announced May 1, 1991.

The winning entry will be guaranteed publication by Alyson Publications, with a \$3000 advance to the author plus standard royalty arrangements. Alyson will also guarantee a promotional budget of \$3000 to help get your new book the exposure and distribution it deserves.

#### Rules:

(1) Only writers who have not previously been published in book-length form are eligible. Staff members of Lambda Rising or the Lambda Book Report or Alyson Publications are not eligible. Writers need not reside in Washington, DC, to be eligible.

(2) Entries must be fictional novels set, in whole or in substantial part, in the Washington, DC, area.

(3) Entries must be received by Lambda Rising no later than midnight, January 31, 1991. Entries must be typed or computer printed, double-spaced, on one side of the page only. Entries must be book-length.

(4) Entries will be judged by a panel of Lambda Rising staff members and five finalists will be selected and announced in May, 1991. The five finalists will be required to sign an agreement allowing Alyson Publications to publish their entry, should they be the grand prize winner. From these finalists, a grand prize winner will be chosen by a panel of five judges to be appointed by Lambda Rising. The judges reserve the right not to award the prize if they feel no submission qualifies.

(5) The grand prize winning entry will be published by Alyson Publications, and the winning author will receive an advance of \$3000 against royalties of the book. Alyson will also guarantee a \$3000 promotion budget for the book.

**Behind the Mask** offers a behind-the-scenes look at the players, owners, managers, and umpires in and around America's national pastime. Funny, poignant, and shockingly honest, this book will open eyes about how the game is really played and officiated and about the deeply ingrained homophobia among those involved in professional baseball.

Not since 1975, when football player David Kopay spoke out about being gay, has another prominent male in professional sports come out of the closet. And never has anyone in pro sports allowed a more revealing look inside a sporting soul. *Behind the Mask* is bound to raise a firestorm of controversy and become a major contribution to the debunking of myths about both gays and jocks.
