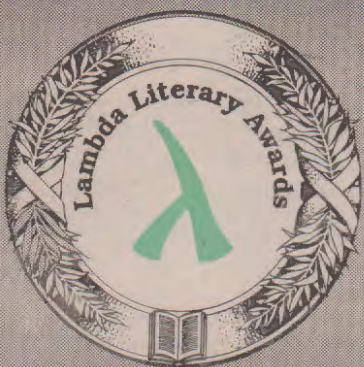

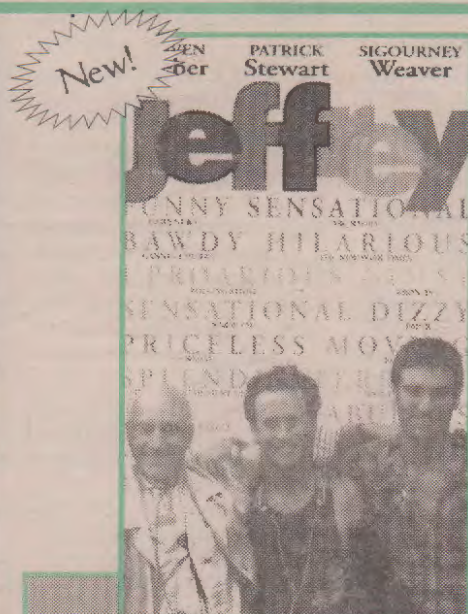

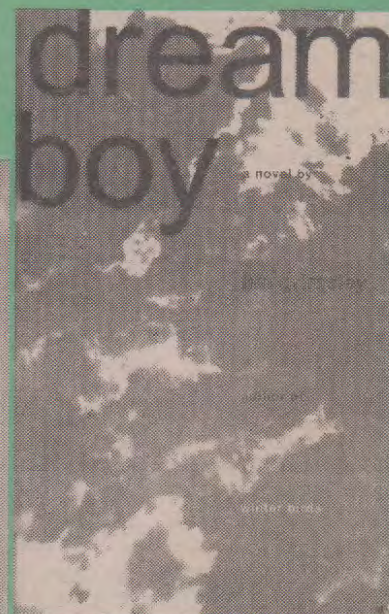

8TH ANNUAL LAMBDA LITERARY AWARDS NOMINATIONS OPEN

Lambda Book Report has opened nominations for the Seventh Annual Lambda Literary Awards. The "Lammys," recognizing excellence in gay and lesbian writing and publishing, will be presented during a gala banquet in Chicago on Friday, June 14, 1996, during the American Booksellers Association Convention.

Since their inception in 1989, the Lammys have witnessed a still expanding publishing boom. Deacon Maccubbin, publisher of the *Lambda Book Report*, which sponsors the Awards, said "This year marked the maturation of the gay and lesbian book industry, as many of the books that a few years ago made news for their six

figure author advances from mainstream houses began to appear on the shelves. At the same time, the gay and lesbian small presses continue to thrive and expand. As a result, the pool from which we draw the finalists and winners of the Lambda Literary Awards grows in size and depth. We are proud of the part that the Lammys have played in developing and celebrating our literary tradition."

One sign of the industry's maturation is that most categories remain the same this year as last. The one addition is a Religion/Spirituality category reflecting the intense interest within the community in these issues. Last year's decision to include English language titles published

outside the U.S., but distributed here, was a great success and continues this year. The public is invited to nominate their favorite gay and lesbian books of 1995 in 19 categories: Lesbian Fiction, Gay Men's Fiction, Lesbian Studies, Gay Men's Studies, Gay and Lesbian Anthologies/Fiction, Gay & Lesbian Anthologies/Nonfiction, Lesbian Biography/Autobiography, Gay Men's Biography/Autobiography, Lesbian Mystery, Gay Men's Mystery, Lesbian & Gay Humor, Lesbian & Gay Science Fiction/Fantasy, Lesbian & Gay Photography/Visual Arts, Lesbian & Gay Spirituality/Religion, Lesbian & Gay Drama, Lesbian Poetry, Gay Men's Poetry, Lesbian & Gay Small Press Book Award (for a single book published by a gay men's or lesbian press), and Children's/Young Adult, for the increasing number of gay and lesbian related books aimed at young readers.

Books must have a 1995 copyright date in order to be eligible and must be available in the United States. Nomination forms must be returned to *Lambda Book Report* offices by the February 23 deadline. Books need be nominated only once to be considered.

Five finalists in each category will be announced on March 1, 1996. One hundred-four judges, representing a broad cross-section of the entire lesbian and gay literary community, will then select a single book in each category from among the finalists. Award recipients will not be announced until the night of the banquet.
