A Capital Contest for New Authors

Have you ever dreamed about being a writer? If you are like most of us, you've probably thought about someday writing "the great American novel" and becoming a famous author. Well, stop dreaming. Now's your chance!

Enter A Capital Contest and become a published author! Lambda Rising, in conjunction with Alyson Publications, invites you to submit a novel set, in whole or in large part, in Washington, DC. Every subject is fair game and novels in any fictional genre will be eligible. This contest is for new writers, so to be eligible you must not have had book-length fiction published previously. Be sure to read the contest rules below for full details.

Deadline for submission of your novel is January 31, 1991. Members of Lambda Rising's staff will select five finalists from the entries and the winner will be announced May 1, 1991. The winning entry will be guaranteed publication by Alyson Publications, with a \$3000 advance to the author plus standard royalty arrangements. Alyson will also guarantee a promotional budget of \$3000 to help get your new book the exposure and distribution it deserves.

Rules:

(1) Only writers who have not previously been published in book-length form are eligible. Staff members of Lambda Rising or the Lambda Book Report or Alyson Publications are not eligible. Writers need not reside in Washington, DC, to be eligible.

(2) Entries must be fictional novels set, in whole or in substantial part, in the Washington, DC, area.

(3) Entries must be received by Lambda Rising no later than midnight, January 31, 1991. Entries must be typed or computer printed, double-spaced, on one side of the page only. Entries must be book-length.

(4) Entries will be judged by a panel of Lambda Rising staff members and five finalists will be selected and announced in May, 1991. The five finalists will be required to sign an agreement allowing Alyson Publications to publish their entry, should they be the grand prize winner. From these finalists, a grand prize winner will be chosen by a panel of five judges to be appointed by Lambda Rising. The judges reserve the right not to award the prize if they feel no submission qualifies.

(5) The grand prize winning entry will be published by Alyson Publications, and the winning author will receive an advance of \$3000 against royalties of the book. Alyson will also guarantee a \$3000 promotion budget for the book.

This brightly colored orange lambda on royal blue background was the symbol designated by the Gay Activists Alliance of New York to represent gay liberation in 1970. The lambda was adopted as the international symbol in 1974 by the Gay Rights Congress in Edinburgh. (actual size 3.5 x 3.5 inches)

Homosexual prisoners confined to death camps in Nazi Germany were forced to wear pink triangles. They constituted the lowest rung in the camp hierarchy. Since the Holocaust the pink triangle has become a symbol with which to remember the persecution and oppression of our people. "Never Again!" (actual size 3.5 x 3.5 inches)

A graphic variation on the pink triangle sticker, also symbolizing the persecution and oppression of gays and lesbians. The white circle offsets the triangle making it more pronounced. This works well on a car/truck's bumper, in a rear window, or wherever a statement can be made. (actual size 3.5 x 3.5 inches)

The colorful rainbow sticker is a more discreet statement. It is not as well known as the lambda and pink triangle and recently it has been adopted by other organizations such as the Rainbow Coalition. It represents the diversity of the gay and lesbian community and our inclusion in society. (actual size 3 x 4.5 inches)

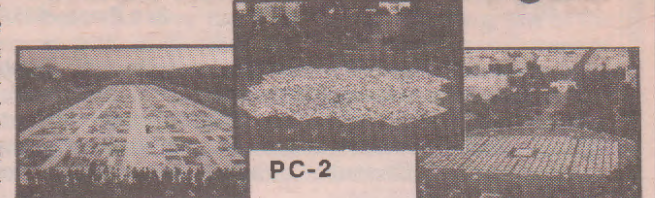
