## Lambda Rising gains local, national praise!

We knew it all along, but it was good news when Baltimore's *City Paper* named Lambda Rising's Baltimore store the city's "Best Alternative Bookstore."

The paper's glowing encomium began by saluting store manager Jack Garman, noting that among the locals the store is "also known affectionately as 'Jack's.'" The kind of feeling the store evokes was also mentioned: "[Lambda Rising/Baltimore] also doubles as an unofficial community center, providing free newspapers, flyers, a bulletin board and free phone advice (especially for visitors and people new to the area)."

The store's readings came in for praise, too, including "a particularly successful one

## November Brings Neil Miller, The New Joy of Gay Sex

Poet Steve Riel, **Homoerotic Photography** editor round out a busy month

"My friends flow best adlibbing on tiptoe," writes Steve Riel, "I'm least awkward alone, in a poem." A former Washington, D.C. resident (and Lambda Rising employee), Riel, now with Amherst University's publications department, has just published his first book of poetry, *How to Dream*. These are poems of tenderness and humor, both self-regarding, and fixed on the world outside, where gay men are guests at weddings, and have house guests with AIDS. Reviewing *How to Dream*, Poet Jeffrey Beam says that "Riel can write a fine line."

Steve Riel will read from and sign *How to Dream* Tuesday, November 17, from 6-7:30 p.m. at Lambda Rising/D.C.

Neil Miller's 1989 book, *In Search of Gay America*, was an award winning hit, a brilliantly humane tour of gay men and lesbians changing lives, especially brilliant in uncovering gay life in small towns and rural America. Now Miller has taken his journal-

istic skills out of the country in his new book, *Out in the World: Gay and Lesbian Life from Buenos Aires to Bangkok*.

Miller says that he "didn't start out with any grand theory I wanted to prove. My intention was to let my subjects tell their own stories." While looking at some of the same

topics—sexuality, relationships, politics, social patterns, AIDS—*Out in the World* demonstrates that gay and lesbian life abroad is quite different from these countries. Miller introduces us to a vivid cast of characters: lesbian teenagers and gay gold miners in

## Jewish Lesbian Fiction, Lesbian-Feminist Resistance

Jyl Lyn Felman & Valerie Miner remembering, making identity

Suddenly, the bookshelves are filled with Jewish lesbians exploring their dual identities. For Jyl Lyn Felman, that exploration begins with food: "Eating chicken is the ritualization of my identity as a Jew; when I ate only green things from the earth, I began to forget the smells of my mother's kitchen and my grandmother's kitchen. I began to forget that being a Jew was remembering. Everything."

Felman's first collection of stories, *Hot Chicken Wings*, dives deeply into what that Jewish heritage means to her. "Her language is crisp, vivid, and evocative," wrote Yvonne Zipter in *The Lambda Book Report*. Often humorous, they also have an edge of melancholy. "Jyl Lynn Felman confronts race and

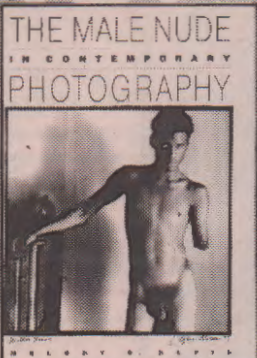

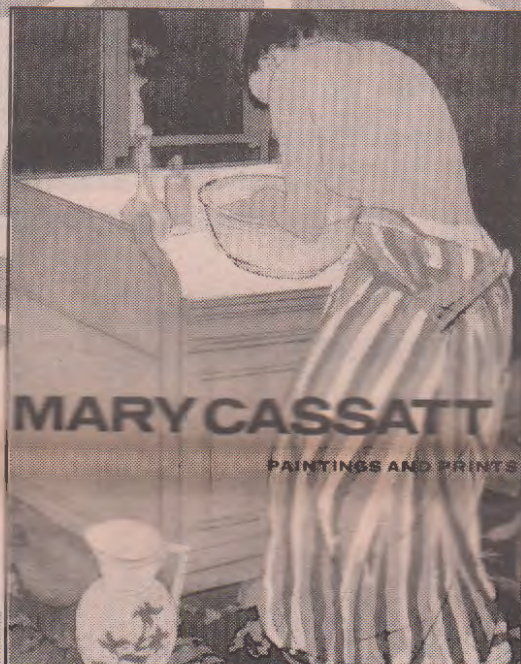

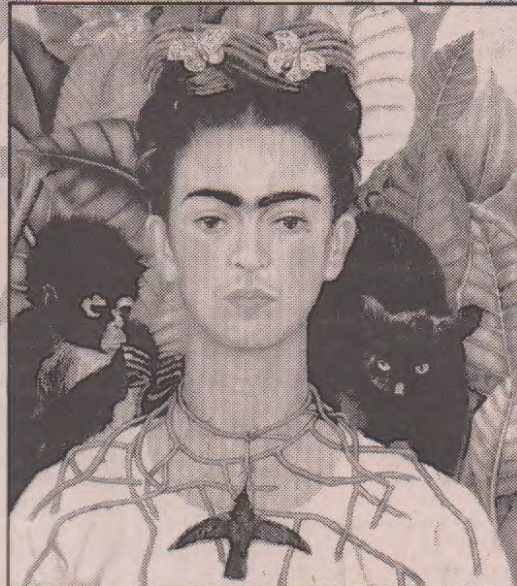

South Africa, "bar boys" in Thailand, an Australian aboriginal man, and a young lesbian in Czechoslovakia. In Denmark, Miller finds same-sex marriages legal, but in Egypt, the Western idea of "gay" is completely alien to Egyptian men who routinely have sex with other men.

Neil Miller will read from and sign *Out in the World* Wednesday, November 18, from 6-7:30 p.m. at Lambda Rising/D.C.

There have been many books of male nude photography. But there's never been a book like Allen Ellenzweig's *The Homoerotic Photograph*. Ellenzweig has taken a look at the entire history of photography and asked what these photographs tell us not just about art, but about cultural attitudes toward male beauty, male sexuality and homosexuality. And Ellenzweig asks as well what taking "homoerotic" pictures has contributed to photography.

The result is a book of great physical and intellectual beauty. Miller illustrates his large format text with 127 exquisitely reproduced duotones. More over, he has contributed a text that places each artist in a historical context, from the male nude studies of artists such as Thomas Eakins to the controversy over the late Robert Mapplethorpe's work

that has made "homoerotic" a household word. It's a book whose breath taking beauty was made possible by the support of a major university press—a sign of the way gay life is making an impact on American life.

Allen Ellenzweig will read from and sign *The Homoerotic Photograph* Friday, November 20, from 6-7:30 p.m. at Lambda Rising/D.C.

The first wave of gay revolution officially arrived with the 1977 publication of *The Joy of Gay Sex*, by Dr. Charles Silverstein and Edmund White. Published by a mainstream press and covering gay male sexuality from A to Z, it was a clear sign that the clouds of repression had gone, and gay sexuality was taking its place in American life.

In the fifteen years that have passed, much has changed—changes that are addressed in the *New Joy of Gay Sex* by Dr. Charles Silverstein and novelist Felice Picano. The new edition reflects the changing times, and the need to educate gay men about safe sex, about the varieties of sexual behavior, and the creation of alternative families within the gay community. The text has been completely revised, and there are new illustrations, along with lots of practical advice on topics such as coming out, drugs, parents, insurance and loneliness. And with unflinching entries on topics like bestiality and pedophilia, it's also a book that has already been generating some controversy.

Dr. Charles Silverstein and Felice Picano will sign *The New Joy of Gay Sex* Friday, November 20, from 6-7:30 at Lambda Rising/Baltimore, and on Saturday, November 21, from 1-3 p.m. at Lambda Rising/D.C.

### Julie Bremer: It's a Family Thing

Some of the credit for Lambda Rising Sales Associate Julie Bremer coming to work at Lambda Rising/D.C. has to go to her sister.

Julie had graduated from college (Miami University in Ohio) and had returned to her small (population 2,000) West Virginia hometown to work in a crisis center. "I wasn't very happy," Julie recalls. "I couldn't find the community."

That's where Julie's sister comes in. She had a friend in Washington, D.C. who was looking for a roommate.

And did Julie's sister understand Julie's situation. "Oh yes," Julie says, "she's a lesbian too."

The two sisters, only a year apart in age, are, Julie says, very close. "She came out to me my second year of college," Julie says, adding, "but I already knew." Julie in turn came out during her senior year of college and her sister was "very excited for me. She said she was waiting." At first, she says, her family wasn't thrilled with learning they had two lesbian daughters, but that things have turned around, and her mother has joined Parents and Friends of Lesbians and Gays.

Julie loves being in the nation's capital. She was working at Walden Books when she joined the Lambda Rising staff, in part, she says, because she wanted to be more "out." An avid reader, she particularly likes poetry (she names Becky Birtha and Marge Piercy

as favorite writers) and fiction, recommending Fried Green Tomatoes and *Bastard Out of Carolina* as recent reads. And she paints—water colors.

Since joining the staff, the most dramatic time at the store was the weekend the Quilt was in Washington. "I was very surprised," by the huge crowds thronging the store, she says. "It was great, exciting, and by the end, very tiring." What made it enjoyable, she says, was that the "customers were really nice. They put up with the wait, and they let us know they were glad we exist as a bookstore."

ethnicity with a badly needed authority," says Sabrina Sojourner.

Award winning writer Valerie Miner is perhaps best known for her novels, such as *All Good Women and Murder in the English Department*, as well as her collection, *Trespassing and Other Stories*. But she is also a very gifted essayist, critic and theorist, whose work has appeared in *The New York Times Book Review*, *Conditions*, *The Washington Post* and many other publications.

Recently, Miner collected much of this writing in *Rumors from the Cauldron: Selected Essays, Reviews & Reportage*. It is a brilliant volume, one that challenges the notion that "trendy" equals "excellent," that affirms there is a connection between lesbianism and feminism, but that the connection is by no means simple and identical. Above all, she shows a mind that is subtle and far reaching.

for Black History Month." Add in the expanded space and the longer hours, and the total package, the *City Paper* concluded, accounts for the store's "phenomenal success."

Also impressed with Lambda Rising was *Entrepreneur* magazine, which selected one business from each state and the District of Columbia to be featured in its June issue. Lambda Rising was selected as the D.C. representative. *Entrepreneur* noted the bookstore's success in growing to three retail outlets, a wholesale division, a mail order division and a magazine publishing arm.

Finally, the *Lambda Book Report*, the bimonthly book review magazine published by Lambda Rising, came in for praise from *USA Today*. The national newspaper devoted a paragraph of its "Books and Magazine" column to the *Lambda Book Report*, saying that the "literate bimonthly" was "a genuine delight for any book lover." We like *USA Today's* comment that the magazine has "witty and wise words of advice for would-be writers of any or all sexual persuasions."

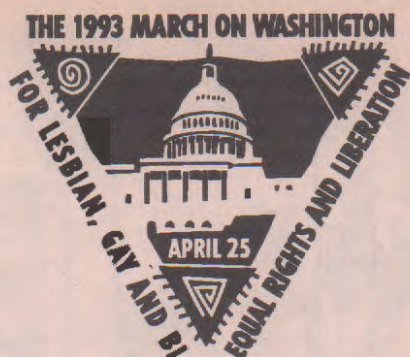
