Spring is in the air at Lambda Rising

What is the "voice of Baltimore"? Lambda Rising/Baltimore aims to find out. The bookstore is hosting its annual Spring Readers' Series this year in February and March, using the theme "Finding a Baltimore Voice."

The series runs through Black History Month and Women's History Month and features writers and performers from the Baltimore, Maryland area. This series seeks to increase both the quantity and quality of the prose craft in Baltimore, and to give our home grown writers a podium from which they can strive toward a distinct geographic and cultural literary voice representing Baltimore.

The Lambda Rising/Baltimore reading series is an extremely popular event every year, and promises to pack the store again in 1994 with this diverse coterie of writers. All readings begin at 3:00 p.m. and are free to the public.

BLACK HISTORY MONTH READINGS

Sunday, February 13, poet and gospel singer Tom Presley is joined by Baltimore poets Darrell Forney and Craig Reynolds.

Sunday, February 20, African American poet-performers Vel Wheeler, Jaki-Terry, and Andrea Ross-Greene appear along with Alma Roberts, publisher of New Breezes: An Anthology of African American Literary Voices. Ms. Roberts is considered by many to be the vanguard of the African American literary presence in Baltimore.

Sunday, February 27, poets and short story writers Reggie Harris and Brian Lyles are the featured readers, and there will be an open mike forum

for other writers who wish to read. (Please contact Lambda Rising/Baltimore at 410-234-0069 or sign up at the reading.)

WOMEN'S HISTORY MONTH READINGS

Sunday, March 6, poets Linda Joy Burke, Jocelyn Garlington, and Natalie Towles will read from their work to launch the first week of the series during Women's History Month.

Sunday, March 13, poet Elaine Upton (winner of the Columbia Book Award), poet Gina Coffman, and short fiction writers Teresa Palomar and Janet Goldstein are the featured readers.

Sunday, March 20, literary magazine publisher Monique St. Lawrence and young Baltimore poet Anna Swigert share the podium, with special guest, William Percy, co-author of *Outing: Shattering the Conspiracy of Silence*.

The series ends on a high note on Sunday, March 27.

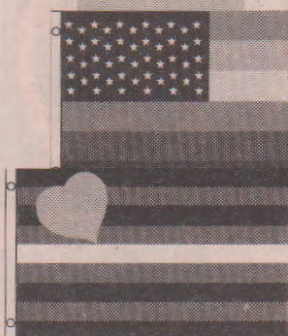

with the appearance of Shirley Hartwell, Alice Aldrich, Sue Jordan, Ava Chitwood, Rena Howl, and Mary Kitner as moderator. These women make up a well-established writing group in Baltimore, and this appearance at Lambda Rising marks only the second time these women have read together as a group.

AUTHOR APPEARANCES AND SIGNINGS

The Spring new book season is rolling off to an exciting start this year with a number of signings at the Lambda Rising stores. Spring 94 promises to be a busy season for us, as hundreds of new gay, lesbian, and bisexual books will be published between now and the first of June. A large number of them are featured in this catalog, with even more new titles coming in our next issue. It's going to be a hot Summer!

Tuesday, February 15 from 6:30 until 8:00 p.m., body builders Rod and Bob Jackson-Paris visit Lambda Rising/DC to read discuss and sign their biography, *Straight From the Heart: A Love Story*. This is the compelling story of Bob Paris and Rod Jackson, who met, fell in love, and ultimately married in the Unitarian church. Their story chronicles

their lives before they met, during their courtship, their marriage, and their life as a couple, and as gay rights spokespeople. An inspiring story of two courageous men who have fought prejudice, rejection, and the ignorance and fear of others—and have turned their experience into positive power.

David Drake visits two Lambda Rising stores in March to read from, discuss, and sign copies of his play, *The Night Larry Kramer Kissed Me*. The play is a series of meticulously-crafted scenes that are alternately lyrical, brutal, and hilarious: from a tender portrait of the pain of a gay adolescent and the fearful thrill of coming out, to an incisively hilarious take on body-building that segues into a call to arms against anti-gay violence, to a hellishly sensual descent into the night crawl of pickup bars and back rooms. David Drake will be at Lambda Rising/Baltimore Tuesday, March 8th at 8:00 p.m. and at Lambda Rising/DC Wednesday, March 9th from 6:00 until 7:00 p.m.

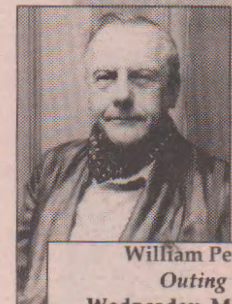
E. Lynn Harris visits Lambda Rising/DC Thursday, March 10th from 6:00 until 7:00 p.m. to read from and sign his new book, *Just As I Am*. In this follow-up to *Invisible Life*, we see the further adventures of Raymond as he continues to search for love with that perfect man and as he finally comes to terms with the fact that he is gay. In vivid prose, Harris also tackles the subjects of AIDS, racism, sexism and homophobia within the African American community. It is a moving sequel to the bestselling book and a sassy portrait of contemporary black gay life.

William Percy visits two Lambda Rising stores to discuss and sign his book *Outing: Shattering the Conspiracy of Silence*, co-authored with Warren Johansson. The book provides an in-depth look at the phenomenon of outing from the Ancient Greeks to today, arguing that outing is a legitimate tactic for reinforcing the identity and solidarity of the Queer Nation in its struggle for vindication and survival in the age of AIDS. William Percy will be at Lambda Rising/DC on Wednesday, March 16th from 6:00 until 7:00 p.m., and at Lambda Rising/Baltimore on Sunday, March 20th at 3:00 p.m.

In April, Norman Wong visits Lambda Rising/DC Wednesday, April 6 from 6:00 until 7:00 p.m. to read from and sign his novel, *Cultural Revolution*. This sequence of twelve interlinked stories portrays the Americanization of the Lau family, and especially of the number one Chinese son, Michael Lau, who comes of age with the secret that he is homosexual. This is his story as he tries to come to terms with his family and look forward to the day he can go to a college in the states.
