## Spring Author Appearances at Lambda Rising

We have a busy schedule of author appearances at our stores (also see our front page story on the annual "Finding a Baltimore Voice" reading series at Lambda Rising/Baltimore.) We begin on Wednesday, February 15 when **Laura Argiri** visits Lambda Rising/DC from 6 until 7 p.m. to read from and discuss her impressive new novel, **The God In Flight**. This is a Victorian novel about an illicit love affair between an young student from West Virginia who was raised by a pious reverend, and a professor, a Greek with his own troubled past, at Yale University. The book is a rich, provocative romance of early times in the tradition

of Mary Renault and Marguerite Yourcenar, vividly evoking the times and feelings of people concerning love between men in clandestine romantic affairs.

Tuesday, February 21, local DC-area author **Martine Rothblatt** visits Lambda Rising/DC from 6 until 7 p.m. to discuss and sign her book, **The Apartheid of Sex: A Manifesto on the Freedom of Gender**. Her premise is "There is no socially meaningful characteristic that divides humanity into two absolute groups, men and women." She makes a case for the adoption of a new sexual model that accommodates every pos-

in paperback, and is one of the best "insider" looks at private life in Washington, DC during the early years of the 20th Century. (See Page 3.) Also new in biography this season is the biography of Philip Johnson, the Dean of American Architects, featured on page 4.

In our health and AIDS section, we've just received a new title from England, **Safer Sexy**, which continues in the excellent educational tradition of the sex ed. videos coming out of Britain now, like *Getting it Right* and *The Gay Men's Guide to Safer Sex*. (Videos featured on page 21.) This new book combines a strong safer sex message with photographs to present a striking and useful

This popular reading series features poets and prose writers from around the Baltimore/Washington, DC area who come together as individual artists and writing groups, and present what is best and unique about writing coming out of the Baltimore area. All Sunday afternoon readings will begin at the Lambda Rising/Baltimore store at 3:00 p.m. All readings at our stores are open to the public and refreshments will be served.

Celebrating Black History Month in February, each session will be preceded by a short reading of the work of the late Craig Reynolds.

The first reading will be Sunday, February 5, featuring Ben Walston, Lynn Distance, and Brian Lyles.

Sunday, February 12 will feature readings by Reggie Harris, Darrell Forney, and Monique St. Lawrence.


On February 26, James Earl Hardy visits our store to read from and sign his novel, **B-Boy Blues**, along with a reading by Gina Coffman.

educational message that all sexually-active men should see. This book goes beyond "Editor's Choice" to "Must see."

The genre of AIDS writing continues to grow, and we feel that as a subset of fiction and poetry writing, it deserves separate recognition in our catalog pages. So, beginning with this issue, we will show the latest and best of AIDS fiction and poetry along with our health-related AIDS titles to present a more well-rounded response to what is being done in the fight against AIDS, both from medical research and treatment, and from artistic points of view. (Page 5.)

"What's old is new again" on our men's fiction page this Spring as we feature a set of very important paperback reprints of gay men's fiction that deserve a place in every gay library. This season we saw the reprint of works by Reynaldo Arenas, *The Doorman*, *The Ill-Fated Peregrinations of Fray Servando*, and *Old Rosa*, along with the reprint of Edmund White's classic gay novel, *A Boy's Own Story*. Also, the Lambda Literary Award-winning novel *Living Upstairs* by Joseph Hansen is back in a new paperback edition (see page 6.)

Library building is also the theme on our Spring Gay Studies page, featuring

the book *The Gay and Lesbian Literary Companion*, which is an excellent reference book for an overview of the entire field of gay and lesbian literature. Also big this season is a new anthology of essays co-edited by Joan Nestle and the late John Preston, *Sister and Brother: Lesbians and Gay Men Write About Their Lives Together*. (See page 7)

In women's fiction, we feature the works of three fine and diverse writers: Lesléa Newman has written across many genres from novels to short fiction, to how-to books on writing, and we've collected her most important work here on one page. Also, we feature four novels each by authors Doris Grumbach and Lambda Literary Award winner Jeanette Winterson. (See page 8.)

Editor's Choice on the women's studies page for Spring (see page 9) goes to Pat Califia for her controversial new book, *Public Sex*. This is one of the most thought-provoking collections of essays on sex in the nineties we've seen, and runs in the tradition of Califia's past work, pushing at the envelope to make us think about our own definitions of sex and sexuality, and what it means to be a sexual lesbian or gay man as we approach the next millennium.

In honor of Black History Month, we feature a full page of the best titles

from our inventory covering African-American fiction and poetry, plus important contemporary biography such as *We Who Believe in Freedom*, the story of Sweet Honey and the Rock. And most important among the new releases on this page is *The Collected Poems of Langston Hughes*. This is another must-have book that should be on the shelf of every fan of Hughes, and every student of contemporary African American poetry. (See page 11.)

And if you are a fan of great poetry, check out page 18 for the latest new releases, including newly published works from our featured poets, May Sarton and Marilyn Hacker. Also, for good general introductions to gay and lesbian poetry, we have *The Name of Love: Great Gay Love Poems* and *The Key to Everything: Great Lesbian Love Poems*.

Besides being filled to the brim with great poetic works from our history, the books are small enough to slip into a pocket and carry along to that special romantic rendezvous! And for all of you out there who have requested it, we have a special chapbook of ten poems by W.H. Auden called *Tell Me The Truth About Love*. This small collection includes the poem, "Funeral Blues" from the feature film, *Four Weddings and a Funeral*.

Movie Soundtracks are the name of the game with our Spring music collection (see page 19.) This season, we now have two recordings from the movie *Philadelphia*, both the original movie soundtrack featuring the hit single by Bruce Springsteen, and the original movie score, featuring the background music from the film. A great new find in the soundtrack section is something we're sure a lot of you have been waiting on for years: the soundtrack to the film, *Victor/Victoria!* Also, check out the "resurrection" of the rock opera *Jesus Christ Super-Star*, recorded by some of the top names in rock music, including Amy Ray and Emily Sayers of the Indigo Girls singing the parts of Jesus Christ and Mary Magdalene.

And don't forget our new gay gifts for the Spring season. We have LOTS of new items (see pages 22 and 23), including our exclusive new "Hate is not a family value" license plate frame, a great new bumper sticker—"The Christian Right is Neither"—and our new AIDS Ribbon wristwatches. We've added three new designs to our Pride flags: the pink triangle on a black background, the Christian Rainbow flag, and a new rainbow-patterned bunting that's great for decorating your floats at the next Pride Day parade!

sible shade of gender identity. It reveals that male and female roles are dictated neither by genetics, genitals, or reproductive biology, but by social attitudes.

Mitchell Crawford had always wished and dreamed for a Ruffneck, a hiphop loving, street struttin', crotch grabbin' brotha. And he finally finds one in Raheim Rivers, who is a vision of lust: six feet tall and 215 pounds of mocha-chocolate muscle. Mitchell knows Raheim will take him for a walk on the wild side, especially between the sheets. But he doesn't count on getting behind Raheim's mask and finding

someone he can love.

**Patricia Nell Warren** visits Lambda Rising/DC on Tuesday March 7, from 6 until 7:30 p.m. and the following night, Wednesday, March 8, at Lambda Rising/Baltimore, at 8 p.m. To read from and sign her novel, *Harlan's Race*, the long-awaited bestselling sequel to her novel *The Front Runner*. After his young athlete lover is assassinated on the Olympic track in Montreal, coach Harlan Brown is forced to enter the race of his life, to survive the hate, violence and an unknown assailant which threaten his chosen family: Betsy, valiant lesbian mother, Vince, angry activist seeking revenge, Chino, Vietnam Vet with a wounded heart, and the secret child of Billy Sive.
