THE WOMEN'S CENTER TAKES SHAPE...

Enclosed with this newsletter is a copy of the proposed structure-in case you didn't receive one-including a Coordinating Council and General Assembly. Before we get on to the revisions, here are the dates and times of the first meetings:

REVISIONS TO PROPOSED STRUCTURE

Page 1, #A, 2. A quorum of 20 people is suggested for the G.A.

#B A quorum of 50% of the Council is suggested.

Page 2, #E (Miscellaneous)

1. Any project group can call an emergency General Assembly meeting.
2. Decisions about the structure of the Center can be amended by mutual agreement of the G.A. & Council.
3. Coordinating Council meetings, records and financial records are open to all.

THE LAW IS ON YOUR SIDE (for once?)...

The Women's Legal Defense Fund has offered \$25 a month rent in exchange for space in the Center. WLDF sisters - be sure to send a rep to the Coordinating Council Meeting.

Women's Center Proposed Structure

The following is a tentative structure for the Women's Center which was set up by the 10 women who attended the last general meeting (6/8/72). We are presenting it to what we expect will be a larger group at this meeting (6/15/72) for revision and, hopefully, final acceptance. We propose that the Women's Center should operate according to the revised structure for 6 months and then totally re-evaluate it, based upon experience.

Basically, there would be 3 groups who would make decisions about the Women's Center:

- A. The General Assembly would meet once a month. Anyone could go to meetings and take part in decision-making who:
1. Is a member of any project group or organization that is part of the Women's Center, OR
 2. Went to 1 previous General Assembly (G.A.) meeting in the last 6 months. (Anyone can go to G.A. meetings as a non-decision-maker or non-voter.)
- A quorum of 30 people is suggested for the G.A.
- B. The Coordinating Council would meet once a week. The positions of recording secretary and chairwoman would rotate. The Council would be composed of:
1. One representative of every project group (or organization) that is part of the Women's Center. Right now this includes:

Feminist Counseling	Liberation School
Legal Counseling (WLDF)	Lesbian Office
Rape Counseling	Funding committee
Health Group	Off Our Backs
Women's Phone	N.O.W.
Library	
- We also hope to have a Newsletter Committee, Speaker's Bureau, Day-Care Group, and Job Co-op soon.
- Each project would decide how to choose a representative. We suggest that this position be rotated every 2 - 6 months, in order to maintain some continuity in the Council, without having any one woman serve for too long. Hopefully, the changing of positions can be staggered among different groups.
2. Every paid staff person
 3. Five members of the G.S. chosen by lot (of those willing) every 3 months.
 4. One representative from any group outside of the Women's Center that wishes to participate in the Council, if both the Council and G.A. agree.
- C. The Office Collective would carry out the decisions of the Council and keep up the day-to-day functions of the Women's Center. It will be structured and its duties will be more clearly defined by the Council, to which it will be responsible. There will be both paid and volunteer staff.

Decision-Making

In answering the question, "Who should decide what?" we agreed that decisions which were fairly routine should be made by the Council, and more crucial decisions should require the agreement of the G.A. and the Council. We did not designate any decisions to be made solely by the Office Collective, leaving that to be delegated by the Council.

We differentiated the following different kinds of decisions to be made:

- A. Use of space
 - 1. Temporary--Assigning of rooms for meetings on a particular night or series of nights -- may be done by the Council
 - 2. Long term--Assignment of permanent office space to be used by project group or organization - requires agreement of both Council and G.A.
- B. Paid staff of Office Collective
 - 1. Deciding how many positions should be paid and how much they should be paid - requires agreement of Council and G.A.
 - 2. Choosing individuals for those positions -- may be done by the Council
- C. Spending money
 - 1. Amounts under \$200 may be allocated by the Council.
 - 2. Anything over \$200 requires agreement of Council and G.A. (except already agreed upon, long-term commitments, such as rent and salaries, which the Council may dispense).
- D. Political decisions
 - 1. The Women's Center will not make endorsements of any actions, positions, etc. of any group, whether it is a group inside or outside of the Center.
 - 2. The Women's Center may sponsor a forum on any issue and may disseminate information about issues, actions, etc. to the different groups within the Center. A forum may be called by either the Council or the G.A.
- E. Miscellaneous
 - 1. A treasurer would be chosen by the G.A., and a bookkeeper, who would be part of the Office Collective, would be chosen by the Council.
