

PRINCIPLES AND POLITICAL TASKS OF WASHINGTON
D.C. ANTI-IMPERIALIST COMMITTEE

1. To fight politically and actively against Imperialism, Zionism, reactionaries, against all those who collaborate with U.S. Imp.
2. Unconditional support for the national liberation struggles. Support the heroic struggle of Black People, Puerto-Ricans, Indians (Native Americans) and Chicanos in the United States, and workers and oppressed peoples all over the world. We give unconditional support to the N.L.F. in Vietnam, heroic Pathet Lao, Revolutionary United Front of Cambodia and Palestine Liberation Organization.
3. Recognizing the right of all nations for self determination, and support for equal and full democratic rights of national minorities.
- 4.. Against all fascist and repressive measures taken by the Imperialist Government in the United States.
5. Total equality between all races.
6. Against oppression of women and for their equal rights.
7. To support all political prisoners who are victims of U.S. Imperialism and its lackeys all over the world and expose all repressive measures taken against them.
8. To expose the reactionary regimes and puppets of the United States all over the world, examples of reactionary puppet regimes are Haile Sellasie of Ethiopia, Hussein of Jordan, Golda Meir of Israel, Medici of Brazil, Thieu of South Vietnam and others.

. The Anti-Imperialist Committee is a coalition of several different anti-imperialist organizations working together without trying to modify the specific ideological stands of participating member organizations.

The Committee believes that the foremost struggles being waged against imperialism in general and U.S. imperialism in particular are the National Liberation struggles throughout the world. These struggles depend to a great degree on the active support of the Anti-Imperialist movement of other nations including the U.S. We see our role to expose world imperialism and particularly U.S. imperialism, and reactionary puppets, and to raise the Anti-Imperialist consciousness of the people in the area, extend our influence and bring our ideas to more people.

ON ORGANIZATIONAL PROCEDURES

1. The assigned representatives of the member org. will form the Executive Committee of A.I.C.
2. The 1+1 (simple majority) decision vote on the basis of each organization having one vote, will authorize the comm. to carry out decisions.
3. The minority shall abide the majorities decision.
4. Individuals cannot be members of A.I.C. But are welcomed to participate in the Committee's activities.
5. One person can only be official representative of only one org..
6. The organizations who have participated in A.I.C. activities in the past, who are present in formulating the principles and modifying A.I.C. are considered official members. The new members to A.I.C. will be accepted according to both;
 1. Those who accept the principles.
 - 2.. The vote of Committees simple majority rule.
