According to latest news, the military dictatorship of the Shah in Iran through its notorious secret police (SAVAK), has once again begun to intensify its oppressive reign of terror. A group of Iranian revolutionaries who for long were under constant torture, have recently been sentenced to death by Shah's military court.

In this period of Iranian history, when anti-imperialist and democratic movement of the Iranian people has placed as its number one task to overthrow the reactionary puppet regime of the Shah in Iran, and to expell all imperialist forces, we are witnessing an ever-increasing emergence of revolutionary fighters who place their lives on the line in order to defend the interests of Iranian toiling masses. The revolutionaries sentenced to death are good examples.

In serving world imperialism and reactionary classes in Iran which it represents, the regime of the Shah has constantly maintained the most despotic attitude against the opposition. The mildest criticism of the regime is followed by a brutal repression.
