



WE ARE ON STRIKE BECAUSE....

- 1. We won an election conducted by the FEDERAL GOVERNMENT (National Labor Relations Board) on October 26, 1973.
- 2. We requested better wages and better working conditions...
 - a. We are seeking a 5 day 40 hour week, instead of 40 hours spread over 6 days.
 - b. We are seeking SOME PAID Legal Holidays.
 - c. We are seeking a VITALLY NEEDED WEEKLY PAY DAY.
 - d. Our wage being less than \$100.00, we requested a moderate wage increase of \$10.00 weekly. After numerous meetings with Colonel Gore and to avoid a confrontation, our union representatives suggested on January 4, 1974, THAT WE SPLIT THE INCREASE: \$5.00 retroactive to December 1, 1973 and an additional \$5.00 June 1, 1974. A wage still below that of maids in other hotels.

Colonel Gore said that he would give NOTHING. He even REFUSED TO GIVE the union a counter offer. He said he only had two employees that were any good. He forced us into this situation.

We are sorry to inconvenience you, but we will no longer be exploited by our Employer.
